How to Register for Curriculum Classes at Surry Quick Guide To Plan and Register for Classes

1. Go to www.surry.edu and click myKnightLife link at the top of the page

2. Select [WebAdvisor](#) for Students

3. Select [Academic Profile](#) then select [Student Planning](#)

4. Click on [Plan & Schedule](#)

5. In the search bar, enter course prefix - space - course number (example. ENG 111)

6. Once a course is found, click [Add course to plan](#), click on [semester](#) in which you wish to add the class and then click on [Add course to plan](#) again

7. Once you enter your courses, click on the [Advising tab](#), and then on ["Request Review"](#). This action sends an email to your advisor alerting them to your request.

8. Once your advisor approves your courses, click on [Plan and Schedule](#) to add sections. The selected courses are visible on the left of the screen so on each course, click on [View Section](#) and choose times/days (sections)

Financial Aid

The Big Five Rules:

1. Know your deadlines to have a completed Financial Aid file:

Fall - June 1st | Spring - Oct. 1st | Summer - March 1st

Visit [FAFSA.gov](https://fafsa.gov) to begin the application process.

2. Check student email and [myKnightLife](#) for Financial Aid information. These resources are the only ways you will receive Financial Aid correspondence.

3. Don't drop before the 60% date of each semester, or you will have to repay the aid. (Keep in mind that Ws count against you.)

4. Know the Standards for Academic Progress Policy (SAP) and your responsibilities for maintaining your grades and satisfactory progression.

5. If you owe aid, you will owe it until it is repaid. You will not be able to re-enroll or get an official transcript without paying back the aid.

Payment and Refunds

A payment plan option is available each semester, including the summer. There is a \$25 enrollment fee and tuition can be split into payments. To receive a 100% refund, you must drop the class prior to the first day. If not, you will be responsible for 25% of the tuition.

How To Pay Your Surry Tuition Online

If you are making three payments a semester, use the Payment Plan Option:

1. Login to [myKnightLife](#)
2. Click on “[eCashier](#)” in Quick Links
3. Register (Enter account information for payment – Visa, MasterCard, Discover, AmericanExpress & Checking Account)
4. Enrollment fee of \$25 is drafted the day of sign-up
5. Please note: Only use eCashier if you are making multiple payments

Quick Guide to Adding, Dropping, Substituting Courses and Data Changes

Logging In

- On the Surry homepage, select [myKnightLife](#).
- **Under Quick Links**, select **Etrieve Central**.
- If prompted, enter your **student email address** and **password**.

Add Course

- Under **Forms**, select **Student Services Forms**, then click on **Late Add**.
- Click **Add Courses**.
- Choose **option** to search for course and enter **Semester**.
- Click on **drop-down arrow** to select the course to add.
- Provide a reason on why you are adding the course in the text box.
- Click on **Add Course**.
- Repeat as necessary to add more courses.
- To submit, click the **Submit** button located at bottom of the form.

Drop Course

- Under Forms, select **Student Services Forms**, then click on **Drop a Course**.
- Enter Course Title. (example MAT140-01)
- The course's semester will automatically populate.
- Enter Reason for dropping the course. (Choose from drop-down list)
- To submit, click the **Submit** button located at bottom of the form.

Substitute Course

- Under Forms, select **Student Services Forms**, then click on **Course Substitution**.
- Select your Program of Study.
- Select "**Add Course**".
- Fill in the following information:
 - Required Course Code and Credit Hours
 - Substituted Course Code and Credit Hours
- Answer the following question: Have you taken the substituted course?

If no, fill in the following information:

- Reason
- Click **Add Course**
- Repeat as necessary to add more courses.
- To submit, click the **Submit** button located at the bottom of the form.

If yes, fill in the following information:

- Grade Earned
- Reason
- Click **Add Course**
- Repeat as necessary to add more courses.
- To submit, click the **Submit** button located at bottom of the form.



Data Change

- Under Forms, select **Student Services Forms**, then click **Data Change**.
 - Place a check mark by the types of changes you wish to make.
 - To **Change Contact Information**, enter new information.
 - To **Change Mailing Address**, enter new information.
 - To **Change Name**, type in the name change in the appropriate box (First, Middle, Last)
 - Type in any former name(s) in the text box.
 - Click **Attachment** to attach a digital copy of one of the following types of documentation in order to complete this request change:
 - Birth certificate (with raised seal)
 - State-issued marriage certificate
 - Divorce decree (with statement authorizing the name change)
 - Court order
 - U.S. citizenship papers
 - To submit, click the **Submit** button located at bottom of the form.

Curriculum Programs

Associate in Arts & Associate in Science Degree Programs

These degrees allow students to take the first two years of general education credits toward a four-year degree at a fraction of the cost of residential colleges and universities. SCC credits are transferable to the University of North Carolina System's 16 universities and most private four year colleges. The Associate in Arts degree is also offered through the Distance Education Program.

Associate in Fine Arts Degree

This degree is designed to prepare students for admission into programs such as the Bachelor of Fine Arts.

Associate in General Education Degree

This degree is designed for the academic enrichment of students who wish to broaden their education, with emphasis on personal interest, growth and development.



Associate in Applied Science Degree

This degree is earned by completing a two-year program of study that prepares graduates for successful entry into careers requiring specific technical skills such as nursing, computer science programs, electronics, graphic design, and business technologies.

Diploma Programs

These programs allow students to complete a concentrated course of study in a technical program in one year.

Certificate Programs

Certificate Programs can generally be earned with the completion of five or six courses. These programs are attractive to students wanting to learn a specific skill or upgrade existing skills.
