Under the nurse licensure compact (NLC), state boards of nursing may issue licensed practical nurses (LPNs) a multistate license, which allows them to practice both in the state where they legally reside and in all other compact states. LPN licensure requirements vary by state and other individual factors; credentials, training, job experience, criminal history or military service.
